Description: Troustrie House stands alone surrounded by fields with views to the Isle of May. The farmhouse has been lovingly renovated to its original Georgian splendour, retaining the period feel with traditional colour schemes. Arguably one of the best B&Bs in Scotland. Guests have use of a beautiful lounge with wood burning stove where you could happily spend an afternoon with a good book and enjoy the views. The two south-facing bedrooms are named after fairies of Celtic folklore, Shellycoat and Kelpie, and both have outlooks towards the sea. For a special occasion, you may wish to request the Shellycoat room (pictured) as this boasts a grand four poster bed. Lesley uses locally sourced organic food when ever possible. A great place for a romantic hideaway.

Access: Take the A917 to Anstruther. At the mini roundabout in Anstruther head inland on the B9131. At the next crossroads take right on to the B9171 to Crail. Follow the B9171 for ~ 2 miles until you see a sign marked to Troustrie House. Turn right on to a single track road and take next lane on left. It is the last house on right before the lane becomes a track.

Dining Out: **Cellar** in Anstruther: Famous for its Seafood dishes and always a popular place so advance booking is advised..
Seafood Restaurant in St. Monans: Award winning seafood. Expensive for dinner, but good value lunch menu.
The Dreel Tavern in Anstruther: traditional Scottish Inn serving simple pub food. Not the finest of cuisine, but lots of atmosphere in this old bar.
