Description: Ceo Mara Croft is our new favourite place in the Oban area. It's a beautiful house in a beautiful location and is so well laid out that you can tell it was designed from the very start to operate as a B&B. The guests have their own private entrance that leads into a bright living room / dining room space (with views over Loch Etive) and the bedrooms are immediately adjacent. The layout is like a small apartment, which make this B&B ideal for a small group of people travelling together. The bedrooms are very spacious with lovely modern ensuite showers and high quality furnishings throughout. The bedrooms are decorated in subtle shades that compliment and reflect the colours of the views from the windows. As the name implies, Ceo Mara is a working croft with resident sheep, hens and a donkey. It is also located within a short walk of a small beach that you'll most likely have all to yourselves. The B&B is located about a mile west of Taynuilt village and is ~20 mins / 11 miles from Oban town centre, but Taynuilt has a good restaurant and is a pretty little village in its own right.

Access: From the Taynuilt Inn on the A85 near the centre of Taynuilt village, travel west towards Oban. After leaving the village 30 mph zone, the A85 climbs gently and passes through some bends before coming to a long straight stretch. The exit for Ceo Mara Croft is signposted on your right at the start of the straight. It is ~1 mile from the Taynuilt Inn.

Dining Out: [Taynuilt Inn](#) – the Inn is easy to find in the centre of Taynuilt and has a cozy olde worlde feel about it, even if the décor is a bit “staged” in places. The menu has typical pub food options, but it is well done. Tel: 01866 822437
